SERVICE PURCHASE ORDER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE COUNTY: The County shall provide information as necessary or requested by the Contractor to enable the Contractor's performance under this Agreement.
- 2. TERM: The term of this Agreement shall be for no more than one year from the date of this purchase order unless other wise noted on the first page of this document.
- 3. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR: In providing services under this Agreement, the Contractor acts as an independent contractor and not as an employee of the County. The Contractor shall be solely and entirely responsible for his/her acts, and the acts of his/her employees, agents, servants, and subcontractors during the term and performance of this Agreement. No employee, agent, servant, or subcontractor of the Contractor shall be deemed to be an employee, agent, or servant of the County because of the performance of any services or work under this Agreement. The Contractor, at its expense, shall procure and maintain workers' compensation insurance as required by law. Pursuant to the Workers
 Compensation Act § 8-40-202(2)(b)(IV), C.R.S., as amended, the Contractor understands that it and its employees and servants are not entitled to workers' compensation benefits from the County. The Contractor further understands that it is solely obligated for the payment of federal and state income tax on any moneys earned pursuant to this Agreement.
- 4. NONDISCRIMINATION: The Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or qualified applicant for employment because of age, race, color, religion, marital status, disability, sex, or national origin. The Contractor agrees to post in conspicuous places, available to employees and applicants for employment, notices provided by the local public agency setting forth the provisions of this nondiscrimination clause.
- 5. INDEMNIFICATION: The Contractor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the County, its officers, agents, and employees for, from, and against any and all claims, suits, expenses, damages, or other liabilities, including reasonable attorney fees and court costs, arising out of damage or injury to persons, entities, or property, caused or sustained by any person(s) as a result of the Contractor's performance or failure to perform pursuant to the terms of this Agreement or as a result of any subcontractors' performance or failure to perform pursuant to the terms of this Agreement.

6. INSURANCE: The Contractor agrees to maintain insurance of the following types and amounts:

6.1. Commercial General Liability Insurance: to include products liability, completed operations, contractual, broad form property damage and personal injury.

6.1.2. General Aggregate \$2,000,000
6.2. Comprehensive Automobile Liability Insurance: to include all motor vehicles owned, hired, leased, or borrowed.

6.3. Workers' Compensation Insurance: Per Colorado Statutes
6.4. Adams County as "Additional Insurance": The Contractor's commercial general liability, comprehensive automobile liability, and professional liability insurance policies and/or certificates of insurance shall be issued to include Adams County as an "additional insured," and shall include the following provisions:
6.4.1. Underwriters shall have no right of recovery or subrogation against the County, it being the intent of the parties that the insurance policies so effected shall protect both parties and be primary coverage for any and all losses resulting

from the actions or negligence of the Contractor.

6.4.2. The insurance companies issuing the policy or policies shall have no recourse against the County for payment of

any premiums due or for any assessments under any form of any policy.
6.4.3. Any and all deductibles contained in any insurance policy shall be assumed by and at the sole risk of the

6.5. Licensed Insurers: All insurers of the Contractor must be licensed or approved to do business in the State of Colorado. 7. TERMINATION:

7.1. For Cause: If, through any cause, the Contractor fails to fulfill its obligations under this Agreement in a timely and proper manner, or if the Contractor violates any of the covenants, conditions, or stipulations of this Agreement, the County shall thereupon have the right to immediately terminate this Agreement, upon giving written notice to the Contractor of such termination and specifying the effective date thereof.

7.2. For Convenience: The County may terminate this Agreement at any time by giving written notice as specified herein to the other party, which notice shall be given at least thirty (30) days prior to the effective date of the termination. 

Project Overview

It is our understanding that Adams County Colorado is requesting Land Surveying Services and Topographic Mapping for approximately 6000 LF of roadway and adjacent drainage ditches. The survey location is in the Mont View Park Subdivision located in the vicinity from 152nd Avenue to 155th Place along Uravana Street and Telluride Street as detailed in the RFP. As a part of the requested services, sub contract utility location services will be provided and included in the total proposed cost to the County. The referenced underground utility locations and markings will be mapped for design evaluation and general information on the survey.



Project Approach

Mountain Navigation Inc. is proposing to establish a minimum of four (4) survey control monuments positioned by static observation GNSS procedures, referenced to the Colorado State Plane Coordinate System and referenced to the NAVD88 vertical datum for project control and future improvements.

The project is located in the Southeast $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 9, Township 1 South-Range 66 West of the 6^{th} P.M. It appears the C $\frac{1}{4}$ corner and the S $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of the section are present and will be included in the mapping and used in reference to establishment of Right of Way.

Our technical approach is to operate two GNSS/GPS Survey rovers simultaneously to provide the most efficient field mapping production by our standard two (2) man survey crew. We estimate to cut the overall field data collection time by 40% utilizing this two GNSS rover mapping approach. All elevation contour generation and mapping feature locations will be obtained by this method.

Per the RFP, **Mountain Navigation Inc.** is proposing to sub-contract the underground utility location services to **Adept Utility Locators**. The utility locations provided will be included in the mapping final deliverable on designated drawing layers.

In addition to the terrestrial GNSS mapping, **Mountain Navigation Inc.** is proposing to utilize our UAV Drone Mapping capability to provide real time overflight mapping of the project area to supplement the deliverables to the county. This added service by MNI will provide the county with seamless ortho-mosaic imagery, and a detailed Digital Surface Model (DSM) to aid in the overall drainage data analysis, planning and improvements for the future.

Mountain Navigation Inc., per the RFP, will formulate a letter and distribute to each property owner along the survey corridor informing them of the intended surveying and mapping activities, the intended dates of the survey, prior to any survey and mapping activities a minimum of 1 week in advance of such activities.


