Best Practices to Increase Response Rate


"Weight" the Survey Data

- 3,000 total households in Adams County randomly selected as survey recipients:
  - 1,500 in incorporated area,
  - 1,500 in unincorporated area
- 503 total completed surveys (17% response rate)
   277 from the incorporated area (18% RR)
   223 from the unincorporated area (15% RR)
- "Margin of error" of ±4.4% overall;
  - ±5.9% for the incorporated area
  - ±6.6% for the unincorporated area

- Results were weighted by respondent age, gender, race/ethnicity and housing tenure (rent versus own) within the two areas of the county
  - A final weight was applied for the overall results so that the two portions of the county were represented in their correct proportions
- Comparisons by demographic and geographic subgroups are included in the appendices
- Comparisons to national and Colorado benchmarks were made, where available










Percent of Respondents Rating as Excellent or Good


How much of the time do you think you can trust Adams County government to do what is right?

Most of the time, 41%











In general, how well do you think Adams County is doing on implementing the reform measures?

Excellent, 8%






How would you rate the value of services you receive from Adams County for the taxes paid?













#### Priorities: Most Important Services














Percent of respondents rating each as "Excellent" or "Good"



## In Conclusion: "Typical" Adams County Resident

- "Kind of" satisfied in Adams County
  - 54 survey items could be compared to national benchmarks
    - 2 were above
    - 24 were similar
    - 28 were below
  - Ratings of community characteristics were more likely to be similar to benchmarks than were government services

# In Conclusion: "Typical" Adams County Resident

- Open Adams is a mystery
  - Two-thirds of respondents
     were not at all familiar
     with the Open Adams
     reform measures being
     undertaken by the County;
     an additional 20% were
     only a little bit familiar.



# In Conclusion: "Typical" Adams County Resident

Rebuilding trust will take time



- About half of respondents thought that Adams County government generally acts in the best interest of the community and is responsive to residents.
- Only 3 in 10 respondents felt the County did a good or excellent job of being open and transparent with the public.
- Ratings of the overall image or reputation of the county were lower in Adams County than in other communities across the nation and in Colorado.
- Less than half of respondents (44%) believed they could trust Adams County government to do what is right always or most of the time.




How prepared are you and your household for a disaster or emergency (e.g., flood, tornado, blizzard, etc.)?





How would you rate the online (internet) property lookup?





#### Where should future urban growth in Adams County be located?





## Focus Groups

## Focus Groups

- Two discussion groups to be conducted in August
  - Usually recommend same script used with both groups
  - Of the 503 survey respondents, 117 gave us a phone number and/or email so we could invite them to a group discussion
  - Can be held with specific target groups other than survey participants (e.g., business owners)
