



Concert in the Park

Frequently Asked Questions and Rules

Do I need a ticket?

Yes tickets can be purchased [here](#).

Do I have to pay for parking?

No. Parking is free.

Can I bring my own lawn chair?

You can bring your own lawn chair or blanket to sit on the lawn.

Do you have ATMs?

Yes.

Can I bring my own alcohol?

No. Outside alcohol is permitted under the Adams County Parks Liquor License.

Can I bring in outside food?

There will be food and beverages available for purchase. We ask that you do not bring any outside food or beverage for this event, minus one sealed water bottle.

Can I bring my pet?

The only animals allowed on the grounds are service animals.

What time will the gates open?

Gates open at 5 p.m.

Do I need to wear a mask?

Per CDC guidelines, vaccinated individuals do not need to wear a mask. Non vaccinated individuals are strongly encouraged to wear a mask while indoors.

Rules for Concerts

- Shows are rain or shine
- All shows are all-ages unless otherwise noted. Generally for concerts and special events, guests three years of age and older are required to have a ticket for entry.
- Camera policies are different for every event. It is best to contact the venue on the day of the show to find out what the camera policy will be for that night.

For the safety and security of our guests, the following items are NOT permitted into the facility:

- Outside alcohol
- Outside food
- Coolers
- Large Umbrellas
- Tarps
- Weapons
- Laser pointers/pens
- Hard case containers
- Pucks, balls, or other missile-like objects
- Air horns/whistles
- Animals (except service animals)
- Illegal drugs
- Chemicals
- Fireworks, smoke bombs, etc.
- Large backpacks, suitcases, beach bags, equipment bags, etc.
- Skateboards, roller blades, roller skates, roller shoes, etc.

Management reserves the right to handle each occurrence on a case-by-case basis.

- Prohibited items can be show specific, please contact the venue within a week of the show with any questions.
- One factory sealed water bottle (24oz. or under) per person IS allowed in the venue
- All bags, jackets, and guests are subject to search upon entering Riverdale Regional Park.
- Any guests involved in a physical or verbal altercation are subject to ejection without refund and referral to law enforcement.
- Smoking is only permitted in designated smoking areas. Any guests smoking in a non-designated area will be subject to ejection without refund.
- There is NO overnight parking in the lots surrounding the Riverdale Regional Park Complex.
