

Riverdale Regional Park Rental FAQs

Q: What venues do you have available to rent?

Riverdale Regional Park has a few different sized venues to rent.

Al Lesser – seats up to 250

Exhibit Hall – seats up to 800

Waymire Dome – seats up to 500

Rendezvous Rooms (Inside the Waymire Dome) – breakout rooms seat up to 120 collectively

Q: What does the rental include?

The rental includes access to the venue from 7:00am – 11:00pm (some restrictions apply), setup of tables and chairs, and stage.

Rental packages also include bartenders and security for a 5-hour cash bar (see below)

Q: Is there a deposit?

There is no refundable deposit, instead half of the rental fee is due to hold the date.

Q: Can I have my event catered, or bring my own food?

Yes, you are welcome to bring in your own food, or have food provided by a catering service. The Regional Park does not provide catering service.

Q: I want to have alcohol at my event, how does that work?

The Regional Park operates under its own liquor license, so you must purchase alcohol provided by the County.

If you do not purchase alcohol through the County, the bar will be a cash bar where your guests can pay for their drinks.

Q: What are the restrictions on decoration?

Restrictions on decorations include no tape on the walls, no glitter, no helium balloons, and no open flame.

Q: How late can my event go?

Your event can go until 11:00pm. Then you have until midnight to clean up and have your guests out of the venue.

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Q: Can I pay an additional fee to have the venue for an extra hour?

No, the venue rental time is until 11:00pm.

Q: What do I need to do during cleanup?

We ask that you make sure trash gets into the trash cans throughout the venue and pick up your decorations and favors. If you rent the kitchen or use the food prep, those areas need to be cleaned as well.

Q: Can I pay with credit or debit card?

Currently the methods of payment accepted at the Regional Park are cash or check.
