



## Full closures coming on North I-25 Express Lanes project between 120th Ave. and Northwest Pkwy/E-470

### Upcoming Travel Impacts

Work on the North Interstate 25 Express Lanes: 120th Avenue to Northwest Parkway/E-470 project ramps up this summer as crews perform paving operations and overhead sign installation—making significant progress on the project. This work will require the following major impacts to the highway. All work is weather dependent and subject to change.

### Overhead sign installation

**Work hours:** Sundays through Thursdays, from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.

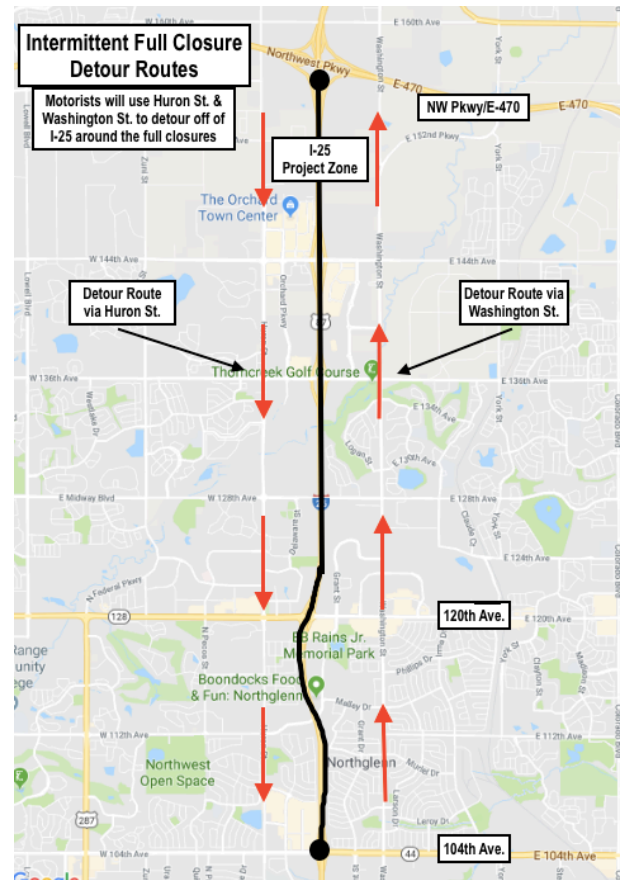
**Impacts:** 9 nights of full closure of a single direction of I-25 for up to 2 miles.

**Description:** Closures for sign installation will occur intermittently between 104<sup>th</sup> Ave. and Northwest Pkwy/E-470, with crews beginning on southbound I-25, working from south to north. Motorists will detour around these closures using Huron Street to the west of the highway and Washington Street to the east.

### Paving operations

**Work hours:** Sundays through Thursdays, from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.; Fridays from 9:30 p.m. to 9 a.m.

**Impacts:** Double lane closures on both directions of I-25  
**Description:** Crews will perform paving for up to three months, starting on northbound I-25, working from south to north between Northwest Pkwy/E-470 and 120<sup>th</sup> Ave. Then paving will occur on southbound I-25, working from north to south. Motorists can expect to drive on a milled surface—it is recommended to slow down and keep a safe following distance between you and the vehicle in front of you. This work will ultimately deliver a smoother riding surface for all motorists, in addition to the Express Lane in each direction.



### Project Background

This project will add capacity with one Express Lane in each direction and provide travelers with the choice of taking the general-purpose lanes for free or driving the Express Lanes for a faster trip in exchange for a variable toll - the Express Lanes will be free to vehicles with three or more people. This project is expected to be complete in summer 2020.
