Neighborhood Parking Program

FAQS

Q- When will the parking restrictions begin?

A- This program is planned to launch in Winter 2021. An exact date has not been set at this time.

Q- Who will be allowed to park on the streets in this neighborhood?

A- Residents and their visitors who obtain permits for their vehicles can park on the streets in the designated district during the restricted hours.

Q- How will visitors be permitted?

A- Each household will receive two physical passes for visitor vehicles to display.

Q- Will we have to pay for permits?

A- Two permits per household will be free of charge.

Q- What happens to a vehicle that does not have a permit?

A- They will receive a warning citation for the first violation. After that they will receive a citation and have to pay a fine.

Q- How much will the fines be?

A- The fine for parking without a permit will be \$21.
