Adams County has partnered with GRID Alternatives, a nonprofit organization, to provide free solar photovoltaic (PV) systems for income-eligible homeowners throughout Bennett, Brighton, Federal Heights, Northglenn, and unincorporated Adams County. Use of the panels reduces homeowners' electricity bills, resulting in annual savings of between 50-90%.
