Adams County Speed Hump Request Form

Speed Humps are traffic calming tools which encourage motorists to reduce their operating speeds while passing over an installation. Vehicles may safely cross Speed Humps at 15-20 mph. Speed Humps have been shown to reduce operating speeds by 40 percent for most vehicles.

It is important to note that while speed hump installations will help reduce operating speeds on a local street, they may result in increased noise levels due to vehicle deceleration and acceleration, potential injury to motorists if traversed at high speed, and longer emergency response times for ambulance and fire department vehicles.

Speed humps may be considered for installation on County roads that meet the following criteria:

- Roadway Classification: Local Residential
- Posted Speed Limit: ≤ 30 MPH
- Traffic Volume: $\leq 2,500$ VPD
- Maximum Lane Count: 2 lanes
- Maximum Grade: 8%
